

Maths ~ Multiplication and Division

1. Kathy buys 18 t-shirts that cost \$35.00 each. How much does she spend altogether???

$$\begin{array}{r} 35 \\ \times 18 \\ \hline 280 \\ 350 \\ \hline 630 \end{array}$$

$$35 \times 18 = 630$$

$$18 \times 5 = 90$$

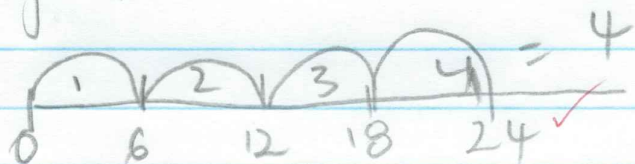
$$30 \times 18 = 540$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 18 \\ \times 5 \\ \hline 90 \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 90 \\ + 540 \\ \hline 630 \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 30 \\ \times 18 \\ \hline 240 \\ 300 \\ \hline 540 \end{array}$$

2. You have 24 cookies and want to share them equally with 6 people. How many cookies would each person get?



3 for free

$$24 \div 6 = 4$$

$$6 \times 4 = 24$$

$$4 \times 6 = 24$$
